How to play:



Choose 5 words and place inside your Differentiated Instruction cube.

Place the fox in the final side of your dice.

Distribute a Gingerbread Man per child.

Children take it in turns to roll the dice and read the word rolled.

If he/she can read the word then a piece is chosen from the basket to build the Gingerbread Man.

Rolling the Fox mean that the child misses a turn and the dice goes the opposite way around the circle i.e. it is returned to the child who just passed it on.

The winner is the first to complete his/her gingerbread man with 2 eyes, a nose, a mouth and 3 buttons.
